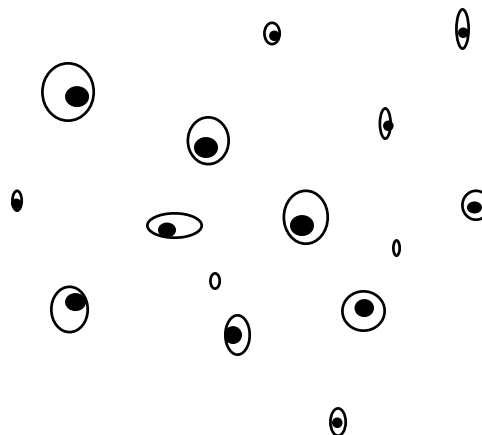


Single Cells!
